Special Meeting day, Aug. 17-1950

A special meeting of the Council was held on Thursday, August 17, called for the purpose of introducing an Ordinance calling for a special election to vote a tax for the erection of a fire hall on the south side of Canby.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Zimmerman, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Irwin, Porter, Kraft and Rupp.

The Recorder then read the ordinance prepared by Attorney Zimmerman, which, however was found not suitable, owing to the fact that he had not received the proper information in regard to certain matters involved.

It was therefore decided that Councilman Kraft, together with the City Attorney and as many of the other councilmen as possible would meet and assemble the various items to be embodied in the Ordinance, the most important of which would be a contract with the Rural Fire District.

Mayor Eversole then asked the council members to meet again on Monday, August 21, at which time a reconstructed ordinance

would be presented for their consideration.
