

Special Meeting
Monday, August 21-1950

The Council met in special session on Monday, August 21 and was called to order at 8.30 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Zimmerman, the Recorder and Councilmen, Irwin, Kraft, Porter and Rupp on roll call; Anderson reported later.

Messrs. Jack Gribble and Russell Rutherford, directors of the Rural Fire District were also present.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called to consider the contract between the City and the rural fire district relative to the erection of a new fire station, and if satisfactory, to again present the ordinance calling for a special election.

After a lengthy discussion, in which the RFD directors joined, it was decided to again postpone the matter and refer the contract to the District Attorney for his opinion, as it seemed advisable to make some changes, which when made would necessitate the reconstruction of the ordinance as now drawn.

The meeting then adjourned.
