

Special Meeting
Wednesday, Sept. 13-1950

The Council met in special session on Wednesday, Sept. 13 and was called to order at 8.15 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Zimmerman, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Irwin, Kraft and Porter. Absent-Beck and Rupp.

Called for the purpose of discussing sewerage matters with Messrs. Ralph Milln, C.E. Stewart, District Engineer, Federal Works Agency and Mr. Roderick of the firm of Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield.

Various problems in connection with the proposed installation of the sewer system were discussed, especially at this time, as to the proper preliminary steps to take in bringing the matter before the citizens.

It appearing that Mr. John Shuler, attorney in Portland had the reputation of being an expert in such cases, that is, as to proper procedure, to follow, where bond issues were involved, on motion by Kraft, seconded by Irwin and carried, the Mayor was instructed to appoint a committee to contact Mr. Shuler and the Recorder was asked to 'phone him for an appointment.

Mayor Eversole then appointed Messrs. Zimmerman, Kraft, Porter and Beck to serve as the above mentioned committee.

Whereupon, on motion, seconded and carried, the meeting then adjourned.
