

Special Meeting
Tuesday, Sept. 19-1950

A Special meeting of the Council was held on Tuesday, Sept. 19 and called to order at 8.15 P.M.

The meeting was called for the purpose of meeting with Mr. Dean Seeger and to get his ideas and recommendations as to the proper procedure to be followed in placing before the citizens, the matter of sewerage installation.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Zimmerman, the Recorder, Supt. Raines and all councilmen.

Mr. Seeger, in a lengthy discussion, presented many suggestions and valuable information relative to the subject involved, and offered to work with Atty. Zimmerman and cooperate with the Council in any way possible.

Whereupon Messrs. Zimmerman and Porter reported having contacted Mr. John Shuler, Portland attorney, in accordance with suggestions made at the last meeting. Mr. Shuler advised against any haste in launching the program and stated it would be necessary to amend the City charter.

It was then moved by Porter, seconded by Kraft and carried, that Atty. Zimmerman be instructed, with the assistance of Mr. Seeger and the League of Oregon Cities, to proceed with the preparation of the necessary legal papers and/or ordinance for the attention of the Council.

Council Beck then called the attention of the Council to the fact that the city dump condition was deplorable and something should be done about it; moreover it appeared that various complaints had been made, that the garbage collections had been somewhat neglected.

It was also reported that Torgeson had sublet or assigned his contract to McNamee and it was decided to ask both men to attend the next regular council meeting and talk over the matter.

Supt. Raines then reported that a cut in had been made on the water pipe line leading to the Gordon Weygandt, Sr. property, but that Mr. Weygandt had objected strongly, stating that he had personally paid for the pipe and installation and if others were allowed to tap on, he would soon have insufficient pressure. Supt. Raines was instructed to inform Mr. Weygandt that the present cut in would be changed later and no others made.

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
