

Re lar Monthly Meeting
Monday, November 6-1950

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held on Monday, Nov. 6 and called to order at 8.15 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, Atty. Zimmerman, Supt. Raines, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Irwin, Kraft and Porter. Absent-Rupp.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting of October 2 and the special of Oct. 6 were read and approved.

There being several visitors present, Mayor Eversole stated that the regular order of business would be suspended and the Council would be glad to listen to anyone having something to present.

Whereupon Sam Amundson and E.H.Taylor spoke relative to the deplorable condition of the Neff Road, which they stated was almost impassable, and relief was promised as soon as it would be possible to operate the grader.

Mr. C. Brewer of the Brewer Pest Control Co. then told the Council that he was giving his personal attention at present to the rat situation at the city dump; also that he was having a new man take over, who would more closely cooperate with the city officials.

John Montgomery asked for information as to the idea of compulsory garbage collecting, stating that if such an ordinance were passed, he thought it would work a hardship on some.

Albin Erickson wanted information as to requirements in laying out a new street through his property and that of J.F.Hudson's.

Ensued a discussion on sanitary conditions and garbage collecting and Councilman Beck stated that his committee would meet Wednesday evening following and report back later.

Reports of Officers

The report of City Treasurer Eid for the quarter ending Sept. 30 was read by the Recorder and accepted subject to the audit of the Finance Committee.

The Recorder reported 11 cases held in his court during the month, resulting in fines assessed of \$ 192.00 - costs \$ 44.50.

Councilman Kraft reported on the operation of the ambulance for September and October, as follows:

Supt. Raines reported that lights had been ordered for the fire station entrance. but not yet received.

Also stated that the C. & M.A. camp grounds wished to have permanent year around service from the City, but that the P.G.E. was objecting. To install our own lines and poles woyld cost about \$ 100, and it was thought the returns would not warrant this expenditure.

It was then moved by Porter, seconded by Anderson and carried, that a committee be appointed to work with Mr. Chas. Dunn in the matter of drawing up a contract with the P.G.E. Mayor Eversole appointed the following: Chairman Porter and Supt. Raines and Councilman Irwin.

Councilman Kraft then stated that some new uniform clothes would be needed for the night patrolman and he was instructed to attend to same.

The Council then approved the application of Frank Rice for a renewal state license and the Mayor and Recorder were instructed to sign same.
