The recorder reported as cases in his court during the month, resulting in fines assessed in the sum of \$220.00-costs \$55.50. Supt. Raines presented and read detailed reports covering the operations of the Light, Water and Street departments for the past yeard. These showed for the light department the number of transformers installed and replaced, new poles set, new lines and extensions and inventory. For the water department-new lines and locations, new pump and chlorinator, meters installed, fire hydra nts, costs and inventory. For streets-materials and cost of grading and graveling and patching pavement, dry wells, street signs and setting grades by Ralph Millin. He also stated that some transformers were overloaded and it would probably be necessary to purchase more during the coming year. Fire Chief Yoder made a short report covering the activities of the Canby firemen during the year. It showed that the department had responded to 67 calls, of which 45 were in rural territory and 22 in the city. The rural report showed losses of \$11175.00 on property valued at \$38500.00 and losses in the city of \$70053.00 on \$124500. valuation; The larger losses in the city being the Ellery Furniture Co. and the Bob Torgeson fires. |

The Recorder then read an ordinance drawn up by the City Atty., at the request of the Council and involving a proposed charge to water

users to develope a fund to be used for future sewer system.

Whereupon, it appearing to the Council that the above did not quite seem to be in accordance with what was needed, the Recorder was asked to write the League of Oregon Cities for more information.

Then ensued discussions regarding housing of the rural fire truck, appointing of a chief for both city and rural departments and salary of same pthese matters, however being left to committee for further consideration.

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
