

Special Meeting
Thursday, Jan. 26-1950

The Council met in special session on Thursday, January 26, 1950 and was called to order at 9.05 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, the Recorder, Supt. Raines and Councilmen Anderson, Irwin, Kraft, Porter and Rupp. Absent-Beck.

The mayor announced that the meeting had been called to meet with Mr. Gus Norwood of the N.W. Public Power Association relative to additional electric power necessary for Canby's needs.

A letter from Dr. Raver was read, in which he referred to the proposal of the Portland General Electric to build a new line to Salem, passing through Canby and asking that the Council members write him as to their ideas in the matter.

Mr. Norwood and Mr. Raines having prepared a rough answer to Dr. Raver's letter, it was submitted to the Council and after a few changes and additions, it was moved by Irwin, seconded by Anderson and carried, that the letter be approved and signed by all members of the Council and the Mayor and certified to by the Recorder and forwarded to Bonneville.

The meeting then adjourned.
