

Special Meeting
June 20-1949

The Council met on Monday, June 29-1949 and was called to order at 8.30 P.M.

Present: Mayor Markee, Supt, Raines, Chief of Police Hudson, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Eversole and Rupp.

The Mayor announced that the Council would first act as a Levyig Board in connection with the proposed Budget for the following fiscal year and would listen to any objections or remonstrances by any person.

The Recorder then read the proposed budget, the same having been duly published in the Canby Herald issues of May 26 and June 2, 1949 in accordance with Chapter 356, Oregon Laws.

There being no objections presented by any person or persons, on motion of Beck, seconded by Anderson and carried, it was voted to adopt the Budget as prepared, published and read and insert a copy of the same in the minutes of this meeting:

ORDINANCE

Ordinance No. 358, levying a tax of \$ 5450.00 on all taxable property, both real and personal was then introduced, read for the first time, passed and ordered published and to come up for final action at the next regular meeting of the Council to be held on Tuesday, July 5, 1949.

Whereupon Supt. Raines outlined his plans for grading, graveling and oiling various streets and explained the work and difficulties in the installation of the new pump.

Mayer Markee then stated that he had contacted Mr. Wright of the insurance Rating Bureau, asking him to make an investigation of the City's pumping facilities and possibly furnish a statement that might be of use .
