

Special Meeting
Wednesday, July 6, 1949

A special meeting of the Council was held on Wednesday, July 6 and called to order about 9.30 P.M. by President of Council Eversole.

Present: Anderson, Eversole, Irwin, Kraft and Rupp.

President Eversole announced that having received a letter of resignation from Mayor Markee and asking for immediate action, he had called the meeting at once, at the request of Mayor Markee.

Mr. Markee's letter was then read by the Recorder and on motion of Kraft, seconded by Irwin and carried, it was voted to accept the resignation with regrets and the Recorder was asked to compose a communication to Mr. Markee to that effect and submit to the members for their signatures.

It was then moved by Anderson, seconded by Kraft and carried, that Mr. Eversole be appointed to serve as Mayor of Canby until January first after the next biennial election.

Whereupon Mr. Eversole then submitted his resignation as councilman, which on motion, seconded and carried was accepted.

It was then decided not to fill the vacancy in the Council until the next regular ^{or special} meeting. Adjourned.

Special Meeting
Friday, July 29-1949

The Council met in special session on Friday, July 29 and was called to order at 7.15 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Kraft and Rupp.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of appointing a councilman to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of Mr. Eversole, who had been elevated to the Mayor's chair.

On call for nominations, Councilman Rupp submitted the name of Harry Porter, which was seconded by Kraft.

Whereupon it was moved by Kraft, seconded by Beck and carried, that the nominations be closed and the Recorder cast the unanimous ballot for Harry Porter to serve as councilman until Jan. 1, 1951 after the next biennial election.

The recorder then cast the ballot as instructed and there being no other business presented, the meeting adjourned.
