

Special Meeting-City Council
Thursday, Dec. 8-1949

The Council met in special session on Thursday, Dec. 8 and called to order about 8.30 P.M.

Present: Mayor Eversole, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Porter, Kraft and Rupp.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of meeting with the Board of Directors of the Canby Rural Fire District, in order to arrive at an understanding between the two bodies, whereby mutual aid and assistance should be given by both and full cooperation at all times.

A contract or agreement, previously prepared, was then presented and read by the Recorder and after discussion, it was moved by Porter, seconded by Kraft and carried, that it be accepted and signed by the Mayor and Recorder and a copy placed in the files.

The Recorder was then asked to write the Oregon Insurance Rating Bureau for a form of ordinance necessary to be passed, in order that Canby might be re-classified with resulting lower fire insurance rates.

The meeting then adjourned.
