Regular Monthly Meeting br. 7-1949

The City Council met in regular monthly session on Monday, Febr. 7

and was called to order at 8.20 P.M.

Present: Mayor Markee, Supt. Raines, Chief of Police Hudson, the Recorder and Councilmen-Anderson, Beck, Eversole, Irwin and Rupp. Absent Councilman Kraft.

The minutes of the previous meeting of January 3 were read and approved.

Communications.

From State Highway Commission relative to allocation of State Tax Street Funds, Canby's apportionment for the year 1949, being \$ 5511.37.

From Ralph Milln enclosing report of surveyor to the County Court relative to the road known as Road No. 395, a portion of which parallels the City Dump, his opinion being that under the Oregon Laws, this road had been automatically vacated and that on November 14, 1927 a deed was given to the City of Canby by the So. Pacific Co., that almost covers the same ground.

The Mayor then read portions of Legislative bulletins issued by the League of Oregon Cities and relative to road matters, liquor licenses and sewage loans, the consideration of which might be of importance to

the City at a future date.

Reports

Supt. Raines submitted reports of activities of the Light and Water nepartments the past year and inventory of materials and supplies on hand. Also stated that an inspection and capacity measurement of the wells had been made, showing 800 gals per minute for one and 200 for the other. Recommended purchase of new pump.

Also called to the attention of the Council the deplorable condition of some of the city streets, caused by recent freezing and thawing, and which meant future repairs at considerable expense; at present the matter of protecting the roads from further damage was left to the

Street Commissioner and the Supt.

It then appearing that a Roads and Street Conference would be held at Corvallis on February 24-26, it was moved by Eversole, seconded by Irwin and carried, that expense allowance be made to Messrs. Anderson and Raines for attendance at this meeting.
Portions of the report of the Bonneville Power Administration was

then read by Mayor Markee, with explanations and observances. Chief of Police Hudson submitted a very interesting report for the year 1948, explaining the work and methods of the Police Department; also statement of activities for the month of January.

The Recorder reported 27 cases tried in his Court during January,

with fines assessed of \$ 267.50-costs \$ 65.00-net \$ 202.50.

City Treasurer Eid submitted a short statement, showing receipts and warrants paid for the month.

Councilman Rupp reported that a new pump was needed at the cemetery

and was asked to get figures and report back.

Councilman Anderson, Street Commissioner stated that road grader could be rented from Les Gibson for # 3.00 per hour, providing the City

purchased gravel from him.

The matter of installing hydrants adjacent to the warehouses on the Highway was then bro't up and left with the understanding that Supt. Raines would get an estimate of the cost and what cooperation could be relied upon from the various parties most interested.

It was then moved, seconded and carried that Mrs. Decker be allowed

a vacation during February, as per her request.

The following bills and claims against the City were then presented and on motion, seconded and carried, ordered paid and warrants drawn. On roll call-Yeas 5-nays O.
