

Special Meeting
Monday, Febr. 28-1949

The Council met in special session on Monday, Febr. 28 and was called to order at about 9 o'clock P.M.

Present: Mayor Markee, Supt. Raines, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Eversole, Kraft and Rupp.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called, primarily, for the purpose of discussing the matter of laying water mains to provide water service for new property owners in the Airport tract.

After a lengthy discussion, during which, an increase in the minimum ~~rate~~ was considered, but no action taken, it was moved by Eversole, seconded by Beck and carried that the Supt. be authorized to purchase and install water pipe and complete project as follows:

6 inch pipe-Starting at Virginia Ave. and Juniper, south to intersection with 5th. Avenue. West on 5th. Avenue to Holly. *Grant*

4 inch-Virginia Ave. and Juniper East to Locust-Wait Ave. and Juniper to dead end of Juniper. East thro' alley to Locust-South on Locust to Wait Avenue.

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
