

Special Meeting

City Council-Thursday, March 24-1949

The Council met in special session on Thursday, March 24 and was called to order at 8:15 P.M.

Present: Mayor Markee, Supt. Raines, the Recorder and Councilmen Anderson, Beck, Eversole, Irwin, Kraft and Rupp.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of presenting an up to date picture of the proposed sewer system and treatment plant, Mr. Howland one of the engineers being in attendance.

Mayor Markee then briefly reviewed the history of the undertaking for the benefit of the members of the Council recently elected and then asked Mr. Howland to take over.

Mr. Howland went into the matter very thoroughly, explaining the operations of the surveyors and engineers so far and presenting several plans, one of which would have to be decided on before a final report could be made to the Federal Works Agency.

It was the opinion of the members, that the so-called A and B plans (which included the main business district, plus necessary laterals to include the schools) were the best for an immediate sewer project and on motion of Anderson, seconded by Eversole and carried, it was voted that they be adopted.

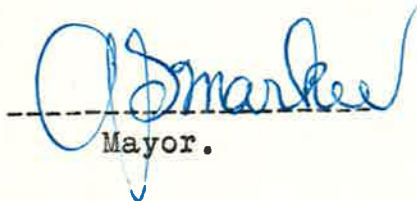
Whereupon the matter of a location for a treatment plant then came up for discussion, it now developing that the present proposed site and under option was probably too close to residential property and of not great enough area.

In connection with this, the Mayor stated that, with the approval of the Council, he would like to ask and appoint C.E. Johnson to arrange for an option on some other site, preferably nearer the Willamette River. (approved by all).

Supt. Raines then stated that he would like some instructions relative to a proposed walk at Third and Ivy, where Earl Oliver planned to erect a residence. He stated that Oliver wanted to lay the sidewalk inside his property line and plant shade trees where walk would ordinarily be located. It was decided to leave this matter to Messrs. Raines and Anderson and so ordered.

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
