

Adjourned Meeting, April 26-1949

The City Council met in session adjourned from April 18, on Tuesday, April 26 and was called to order at 7.30 P.M.

Present: Mayor Markee, Supt. Raines, Recorder Evans and Councilmen Beck, Anderson, Eversole, Irwin, Kraft and Rupp.

Mayor Markee announced that the meeting was being held particularly to listen to the final report by the engineers on the proposed sewerage system and treatment plant, but thought that first it might be advisable to thrash out the daylight savings subject.

After quite a lengthy discussion pro and con, it was decided to stay on standard time for the present, at least until the next regular meeting of May 2, when the subject could again be introduced if desired.

Mr. Roderick of the office of the engineering firm of Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield then presented their final report and drawings of the proposed system and plant, with detailed explanations and answering various questions put to him by the members.

In connection with the report and estimate of costs, it was moved by Irwin, seconded by Kraft and carried, that the City Engineer, Ralph Milln be allowed the sum of \$ 200 for his services.

It was then moved by Beck, seconded by Irwin and carried, that the plans and specifications presented by Mr. Roderick be accepted and the Mayor authorized to sign the same.

It then appearing that it might be advantageous for the City to become associated with the Northwest Public Power Association, it was moved by Kraft, seconded by Rupp and carried, that a membership be taken out in that organization.

Councilman Kraft then stated that the Buchanan-Cellers Corporation were asking that pipe be layed and a hydrant installed at the west end of their building between Grant and Elm sts., most of the expense to be borne by them. Before doing anything about this, it was decided to first contact the Southern Pacific and the State Highway Commission.

Whereupon Supt. Raines reported that Mrs. Lester Brown had requested that the water pipe be installed in her addition, although the streets had not yet been graded. Left to Raines .

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
