

Special Meeting,
Monday, May 16-1949

The City Council was convened in a short special session directly following a meeting of the Budget Committee.

Present: The Mayor, Supt. Raines, the Recorder and all councilmen.

It was moved by Irwin, seconded by Eversole that the budget as set up by the committee be published in the Canby Herald issues of May 26 and June 2 and that June 20 be designated for a public hearing

Whereupon Councilman Eversole asked that a two hour parking sign be placed on Molalla Avenue adjacent to the Ford garage building, the same being agreeable to the Council.

It was then moved by Eversole, seconded by Kraft and carried, that the daylight savings plan should be adopted by the City and all citizens be asked to set their time pieces ahead one hour beginning at 2 o'clock A.M. May 18 and until further notice.

It was then moved, seconded and carried that the bill of Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield, engineers employed for the proposed sewer project, in the sum of \$ 2309.47 be allowed and a warrant issued for the same. On roll call-Yeas 6-nays 0.
