

Regular Monthly Meeting
Tuesday, Sept. 7-1948

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held on Tuesday, Sept. 7, the first Monday being a legal holiday.

Present and answering roll call-Mayor Markee, Supt. Raines, Chief of Police Hudson, the Recorder and Councilmen Eversole, Johnson, Makin, Monahan and Perkett. Atty Zimmerman and Councilman Cutsforth reported later and Councilmen Kraft and Krueger were absent.

The minutes of the previous meeting of August 2 and those of the special meeting of August 11 were read and approved.

Communications

From Oregon State Speed Control Board, in which was stated that the following designated speed zones had been fixed for Canby:

MP 22.268 (north city limits)	to MP 22.57	45 miles per hour
MP 22.57	to " 23.25	35 " "
MP 23.25	to " 23.748 (So. city limits)	45 mi. per Hr

In connection with this matter, the Recorder was requested to write the State Highway Com. with reference to the installation of a "Stop" light at the intersection of Molalla Avenue with the Pacific Highway-99E, and to ask that a representative be sent to meet with the Council and discuss the advisability of such action.

Matter of Proposed New City Charter.

Atty. Zimmerman stated that a copy had been sent to the office of the League of Oregon Cities, but owing to the fact that Mr. Kehrli was at present on vacation, their check-up on same would be delayed for a short time.

It was then moved by Cutsforth, seconded by Perkett and carried, that a resolution be introduced and adopted, calling for the passage of an ordinance, ordering and setting a date for a special election to be held, at which time, the voters of Canby shall adopt or reject a new city charter.

Whereupon at this stage of the proceedings, Councilmen Eversole and Makin presented their resignations, which, on motion, seconded and carried, were accepted by the Council.

It was explained that this was done in order to avoid any confusion to the voters at the coming election, when voting for or against the new charter, which calls for the election of six councilmen instead of eight as at present, and the two above mentioned having been elected to serve until January 1950.

Mayor Markee, then, with the approval of the Council appointed Messrs. Eversole and Makin to serve until January 1-1949.

It was then moved, seconded and carried that the sum of \$ 100.00 be allowed and expended towards the decorations displayed in connection with the County Fair recently held.

Reports of Officers

The detailed report of Chief of Police Hudson was read by the Recorder and accepted and placed on file.

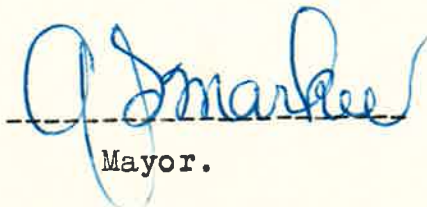
The Recorder reported 29 cases in his Court during the month, with fines assessed in the amount of \$ 257.50-Costs \$ 72.50, net \$ 185.00.

Supt. Raines reported the purchase of a winch for the truck; also recommended that a concrete floor be installed in the garage. Was instructed to get figures as to the cost of the latter.

Councilman Monahan then asked for the opinion of the members as to the logical starting point for house numbering. On motion, seconded and carried, it was decided to number East and West from Ivy and North and South from Railroad Avenue.

It was then moved, seconded and carried to adjourn until Monday, Sept. 13 at the usual time.
