

Regular Monthly Meeting
Monday, December 6-1948

The Council met in regular session on Monday, Dec. 6, 1948 and was called to order at the usual time.

Present: Mayor Markee, Atty. Zimmerman, Supt. Raines, Chief of Police Hudson, the Recorder and Councilmen Cutsforth, Eversole, Johnson, Kraft, Krueger, Makin and Monahan.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting of November first, the adjourned meeting of Nov. 4 and special of Nov. 15 were read and approved.

Communications

From the State Highway Commission relative to pedestrian lanes and the traffic situation on 99E in the City.

From Ralph Milin enclosing list of owners of property in Blocks 1, 2 and 3, whom it would be necessary to contact for the purpose of securing easements for proposed sewer.

From Chief of Police Hudson submitting a proposal for re-routing the busses at the Greyhound Depot, thereby relieving the congestion and reducing the danger of accidents. (Left to Police and Street Committees).

From United Aircraft Corporation to Chief Hudson, thanking him for his cooperation in investigating party applying for a position with them

Whereupon Jack Gribble speaking for the Rural Fire District, thanked the council for their cooperation the past year and stated that the District's new truck would soon be ready for delivery and that the question of housing must be considered at once. It appearing that it seemed best to operate from Canby, the matter was left to the Committee to work out an answer.

It was then moved by Makin, seconded by Cutsforth and carried, that the Police Dept. be authorized to purchase two signal lights for installation at First and Grant sts. and Second and Grant sts.

Reports.

Fire Chief reported only two calls since the last meeting, one at the Rose Cafe (no damage) and one false alarm.

Also stated that the Scramlin building had been inspected by the State Fire Marshall's office, but had not yet received the report.

Also reported that the firemen's school was progressing favorably, considerable interest being shown by the members.

Supt. Raines reported on the completion of the Ivy street program.

Also that many streets needed draining badly and suggested dry wells lined with tile at an estimated cost of about \$ 100 each.

Also stated that a transformer had been installed in the fair grounds for use of the Corn Show about to be held. In this connection it was the opinion of the Council that free electric power should be furnished by the City and also special police service.

The monthly report of the Chief of Police was then read and the Recorder reported 29 cases in court during November with fines aggregating \$ 252.50-costs \$ 70.

It was then moved, seconded and carried that the following increases in salaries should be allowed:

Chief of Police Hudson from \$ 225. per month to \$ 250. effective 12/1/48

Officer Herreid from \$ 190 to \$ 225 per month effective as of 12/1/48

Supt. Raines from \$ 350 per month to \$ 5000 per year effective 1/1/49

It was also moved, seconded and carried that the sum of \$ 60.00 be paid Atty. Zimmerman for extra work and time spent on the new charter. Also \$ 10.00 to Mrs. Ida Nielson for typing .

It was then moved, seconded and carried that the Hi-Way Market's application for the sale of beer for the coming year be approved by the Council and the Recorder was instructed to sign the same in accordance with the requirements of the liquor commission.
