The Council met in special session on Wednesday, December 8 and was called to order at 7.30 P.M.

Present: Eversole, Kraft, Krueger and Makin.

Mayor Markee announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of canvassing the votes cast at the recent special election held on December 6.

Upon checking the returns, the result was found to be as follows:

Proposed 5 mill Tax Levy

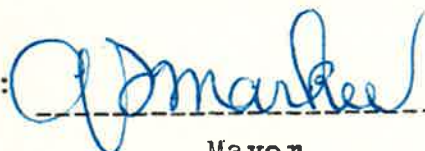
