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# Reports of Officers

Chief of Police Hudson presented a detailed report of his work during the month, covering arrests made, complaints investigated, assistance given to State Police and Sheriff's office and various other matters.

The Recorder reported 35 cases in his court during April resulting in fines assessed amounting to \$ 355.00 including costs of & 87.50.

Fire Chief Yoder reported no fires in April-made various inspections with Deputy Fire Marshal, finding some bad conditions, which are to be corrected. Also mentioned having attended radio meeting in Oregon City, stating that license fee for fire trucks and departments with one set had been fixed at \$\preceq\$ 10.00 per year, which included one check up each month. Also stated that fire chief's convention and school would be held in June at Baker, suggesting that City should defray part of expenses of those attending. In this connection, it was moved, seconded and carried that \$\preceq\$ 150.00 be allowed for this purpose.

Supt. Raines reported on the resignation of Garmire, stating that in replacing him, it would probably be good business to secure an electrician. Council left this matter to Mr. Raines and committee.

Mr. Raines also reported now having a good supply of transformers and poles on hand and demonstrated the use of a Voltmeter recently purchased. he also suggested borrowing a leak detector from Oregon City in order to check water mains for leaks and was told to do so, if possible.

## Reports of Committees.

No reports were presented, but Councilman Monahan bro't up the matter of numbering houses and buildings, stating that in Molalla it had not worked out very successfully, having been left to the owners to do their own installing.

Whereupon it was moved by Makin, seconded by Kraft and carried, that the Mayor appoint a special committee to handle this matter.
Mayor Markee then appointed-Monahan, Johnson and Makin.

### ORDINANCES.

The following ordinances were then introduced, read for the first time, ordered posted and to come up for final action at the next regular meeting of the Council to be held on June 7, 1948:

- Ordinance No. 349 amending Ord. No. 314 governing charges for electric service.
- Ordinance No. 350 amending Ord. No. 304 relating to fixing the compensation and bonds of the Recorder and Treasurer.
- Ordinance No. 351 amending Ord. No. 315 governing curbs and sidewalks in relation to property lines was also introduced, ordered published and to come up for final action at the next regular meeting of the Council on June 7, 1948.

Mayor Markee then announced that the Budget Committee including the members of the City Council would meet on Monday, May 10 in the council chamber at 8 o'clock P.M., for the purpose of setting up a proposed budget for the fiscal year-July1-1948 to June 30-49.

It was then moved, seconded and carried that the Brewer Pest Control service be continued indefinetaly at a cost of # 10.00 per month.

No other business appearing the meeting adjourned.
