

Spe al Meeting
April 21, 1947

A special meeting of the Council was held on Monday, April 21 and called to order at about 8.15 P.M.

All councilmen were present with the exception of Mr. Krueger.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called, primarily, to discuss the water system situation, the amount of pipe required, where it should be installed and other matters in connection thereto.

Councilman Perkett and Supt. Lent explained to the council, the present needs of the system, which appeared to be 6000' of 4 inch and 3500' of 6 inch steel pipe.

Bids were received from Consolidated Supplies-Pacific Waterworks Supply Co.-Waterworks Supply Co. and the Oregon Culvert Co. The first three by salesmen present and the last by letter.

Whereupon after listening to the representatives of the several companies and discussing the matters pro and con, on motion of Makin, seconded by Kraft and carried, it was voted to ~~refer~~ to leave the matter in the hands of the Water Committee, to be reported back to a future meeting of the Council.


Mr. Makin of the Finance Committee then reported that the reports of the City Treasurer for the quarter ending March 31 had been examined and found satisfactory.
