

Regular Monthly Meeting
November 4-1947

The City Council of Canby met in regular session on Monday, Nov. 4 -1947 and was called to order at the usual time.

From Street Commissioner Koehler tending his resignation.

Application of Canby Auto Wreckers for 1948 license, asking for recommendation of the Council. It was decided that this matter should be held up, pending the erection of a fence around the property, or at least, a better understanding as to when it would be done and material used. Reports of Officers

Fire Chief Yoder reported no fires during October.

The report of Chief of Police Hudson was read by the Recorder.

The Recorder reported 46 cases in his court during October, resulting in fines assessed of \$ 449.00 which included costs of \$ 114.00.

Reports of Committees

The Finance Committee reported having checked the Treasurer's reports for the quarter ending Sept. 30 and found same in order.

It then appearing that the contract with Messrs. Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield, Consulting Engineers had been returned corrected, and passed on by the City Attorney, it was moved by Eversole, seconded by Makin that the same be signed by the Mayor and City Recorder and one copy be forwarded to the above named firm. Carried.

It was then moved, seconded and carried that the resignation of Geo. Koehler as Street Commissioner be accepted.

Whereupon it appearing that a vacancy on the Council had been caused by the fact that Neal Thompson had been disqualified by reason of moving from the city, The Mayor called for nominations to fill the vacancy.

Councilman Makin then presented the name of Curtis Johnson, Sr.

There were no other nominations and on motion of Monahan, seconded by Cutsforth, nominations were closed and the Recorder was instructed to cast the unanimous vote for Mr. Johnson.


Whereupon the Mayor announced that Mr. Johnson had been unanimously appointed to serve until the next regular election.

It was then moved, seconded and carried, that the package beer licenses granted the proprietors of the Hi-Way Market and the Rose Cafe, by the State of Oregon be approved by the Council and the Mayor and Recorder to sign the same.

It was also ordered, by motion, seconded and carried, that a contract be signed with the Brewer Pest Control management, the same calling for treatments at the garbage dump for the control of rats and mice. Price and terms as follows: First month \$ 30.00- \$ 15.00 each month thereafter for at least six months, treatment to start Nov. 15.

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
