Reports

Supt. Lent reported the new 10" pipe installed and in use, but lack of pipe for other lines. Also stated that Mr. Makin had again asked about being allowed the use of the old well and pump and cost for same, but not being present to explain just what his needs were in the matter, no action was taken.

Mr. Galbraith caretaker at the cemetery presented no report, but expressed a wish for increased pay.

Mr. Koehler reported having done work on the Fair Grounds road and would need more gravel.

Fire Chief Yoder reported a couple of small fires in May and stated that the Department needed about 200 feet of hose.

Also reported on the Seaside convention as being very instructive and entertaining. Especially mentioned was the demonstration in which fog and foam equipment was used.

Whereupon the matter of the City dump and Torgeson franchise came up for discussion. Sam Amundson urged the Council not to grant franchise to any one, stating that so far the City had been very successful in handling it's own affairs. Left again until the City Attorney could prepare the necessary papers.

It was then moved, seconded and carried that Mr. Galbraith's wage be increased \$ 25.00 per month. It was also moved, seconded and carried that the deed from Wm. D. Rider and wife conveying a strip of land for street purposes be accepted.

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
