Mr. Everts gave a very interesting talk, containing valuable suggestions and information as to financing such a project mentioning that the Council had the powers to levy a five mill tax to provide a sinking fund, if deemed advisable; also that funds could be obtained through the Federal Works Agency for preliminary

engineering work.
