

Regular Monthly Meeting
Monday, November 4-1946

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held on Monday November 4, 1946 and called to order at the usual time. Present: Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Recorder Evans, Chief of Police Kendall, Supt. Lent and Councilmen Berg, Cutsforth, Koehler, Krueger, Porter and Reynolds. Absent-Kraft and Stefani.

The minutes of the previous regular meeting of October 7 and those of the Special meeting of October 28 were read and approved.

Whereupon, Mayor Vinyard announced that the usual order of Business would be suspended and Mr. Everts of the State Board of Health would address the Council, relative to the installation of sewer systems. Mr. Everts gave a very interesting talk, containing valuable suggestions and information as to financing such a project, mentioning that the Council had the powers to levy a five mill tax to provide a sinking fund, if deemed advisable; also that funds could be obtained through the Federal Works Agency for preliminary engineering work.
