Whereupon, Mr. Allman, owner of the Canby Moving Picture theater being present, addressed the Council asking that he be allowed to install a septic tank in the alley in the rear of the proposed new theater building to be erected at the northeasterly corner of Second and Grant sts. Mr. Allman agreed to sassume any risk or damage that might occur in connection with the same.

It was them moved by Stefani, seconded by Cutsforth and carried,

that the above request be granted.

Bob Torgeson then addressed the Council, asking if it would be possible to secure a franchise for the collecting and dumping of garbage, the city dump to be used by him for this purpose.

This matter was left until the next meeting, the City Attorney, in the meantime to investigate similar franchises granted by other

The City Treasurer then submitted his various reports covering the quarter ending March 31-1946, the same being accepted subject to audit by the Finance Committee.

Treasurer Mangus also announced that the Bonne lle auditor had asked that a separate sinking fund be opened for the electric power funds. On motion, seconded and carried, this was left to the Finance Committee.

Councilman reported that several streets had been recently graded, including Juniper and Knott.

Supt. Lent reported 18 new hydrants having been place and 3500 feet of pipe laid in various locations. Also stated that would probably get eight more meters in May and more in July.

It then being suggested that it was about time to appoint "clean up" days, it was decement to name Thursday and Friday, April 18 and 19, the pickup truck to work on the North side on the 18th. and the South side the following day.

It was then moved, seconded and carried that the hydrants be painted, strips adjoining the hydrants and a ten foot strip in front of the fire station.

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
