

Special Meeting-April 15-1946
Cit. Council

The City Council met in special session on Monday, April 15 and was called to order by Mayor Vinyard at 8.15 p.m.

Present: Mayor Vinyard, Recorder Evans and Councilmen Berg, Cutsforth, Koehler, Kraft, Krueger, Reynolds and Stefani.

The Mayor announced that the meeting had been called for the purpose of considering the installation of 10" pipe from the pump house to the springs, ostensibly across the property of Vincent Chiosi and E.O. Mueller.

Both the above named men were present and were asked to address the Council stating what damages they would consider fair in case the above mentioned pipe was laid across their lands.

Mr. Mueller thought he should be reimbursed in the sum of \$ 1000.00, but Mr. Chiosi refused to name any figure, referring the Council to his attorney.

After much discussion, it was decided to take no action until it could be ascertained, at least approximately, what Chiosi would consider his damages in the matter.

The meeting then adjourned.

Special Meeting -Tuesday, April 16-1946

The Council again met in special session on Tuesday, April 16, 1946 and was called to order at 1 o'clock P.M.

Present: Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman and Councilmen- Berg, Cutsforth, Koehler, Kraft, Krueger, Reynolds and Stefani.

This meeting was also called for the purpose of discussing and arriving at a solution as to the laying of larger water pipes, in lieu of the present 6" inch pipes now crossing the properties of Chiosi and Mueller.

After lengthy discussion it was moved, seconded and carried that the 10" inch pipe be laid across the property of E.O. Mueller at a cost of \$ 1000.00 for an easement, which sum was asked by Mr. Mueller as a fair price for same; and that the City Attorney prepare the necessary contract form to be signed by the City and Mr. Mueller. On roll call the voting resulted as follows:

Yes- Berg, Cutsforth, Koehler, Krueger, Reynolds
and Stefani.

No- Kraft.

Whereupon it was moved, seconded and carried unanimously that that a fire hydrant be installed 30 feet east of the South-west corner of the Chiosi property, formerly known as the Wolgamot place.

It was also decided that the 6" pipe now crossing the two above named properties be left as is.

No other business appearing, the meeting adjourned.
