Fire Chief Yoder reported on the fire at the Willis residence loss about \$2000 also small fires at 7 acres-and the R.M.Mann home .

Whereupon it appearing that the city owned three beds, springs and mattresses, no longer required, on motion of Porter, seconded by Kraft and carried, it was voted to sell same and to advertise them in the Canby Herald.

Mayor Vinyard then announced that he had had deeds made by himself and wife to the City for an alley between second and Third sts. and for the continuation of Second St. to the Pfister property and on motion of Krueger, seconded by Krueger and carried, it was voted to accept same and they were ordered recorded.
