June 4, 1945

The regular monthly meeting of the City Council was held on Monday, June 4, 1945 and called to order at 8 o'clock, P.M.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Vinyard and the Recorder then called the roll-Those answering were-Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Kendall, Recorder H.B.Evans and Councilmen Cutsforth, Dedman, Koehler, Kraft, Krueger, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani.

The minutes of the previous meeting of May 7 were then read and on motion, seconded and carried, declared approved.

Whereupon ensued a discussion relative to the installation of a radio set on the fire truck-mainly as to whether or not outside residents should contribute to the expense. No action at this time.

Reports

Supt. Lent reported on test of pumps- probable need of booster pump, which could be rented for \$ 50 or \$ 60 per month.

Councilman Kraft reported for Fire Dept. stating that run had been made to the Schwabauer fire, which was out of control before arriving, but was kept from spreading.

Councilman Keehler, Chairman of Streets and P.F. reported that at least the six blocks first coated last year should be finished now-also presented map showing proposed work. Report was adopted and Recorder was instructed to return maps, marked as to proposed work, to State Highway Commission.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the Council would meet with the Budget Committee on June 19.

The Recorder was instructed to write the State Highway Commission informing them of the bad condition of some of the streets caused by logging trucks.

Whereupon Councilman Dedman reported on the old cemetery matter, stating that the records showed that in the year 1866, a deed had been recorded, to the citizens of Baker prairie by Joslyn, this piece of ground to be used as a burying ground.

The question now seems to be "who are the present owners". Councilman Dedman said he didn't know.

No other business appearing, on motion, seconded and carried, the meeting adjourned.
