

Regular Meeting
September 5, 1944

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Tuesday Sept. 5, 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Everhart, Dedman, Koehler, Krueger, Porter, and Reynolds. Councilman Cutsforth reported later. Councilman Stefani absent.

Minutes of the August meeting were read and approved. Communications from the Dedman Drug Co. and from Dr. F. C. Renfrew advising that the Casualty Station had been closed and refunding to the City of Canby the amount of \$20.58, the City's share of the proceeds realized from the sale of first aid supplies.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the resignation of Ben Hansen be accepted, and the matter be left with the Police Comm.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
