

Regular Meeting
November 6, 1944

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday Nov. 6, 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Dedman, Koehler, Krueger, Porter and Reynolds, also in attendance was Atty. Zimmerman. Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart and Stefani were absent.

Minutes of the October meeting were read and approved.

Communications from Mfg. Trust Co. State Tax Commission, State Board of Health and the City of Gladstone were read by the Recorder.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were ordered paid. Yeas 5, nays 0.

After discussion the following motion was introduced by Councilman Dedman, that Mr. Frank Kendall be appointed Chief of Police of the City of Canby and his salary be increased \$20.00 per month, retroactive to October 16th. On vote of the Council motion passed.

Mr. Ed. Henry addressed the Council requesting the use of the upstairs room in the City Hall by the Canby American Legion Post. Motion was made seconded and carried that permission be granted to the Legion to use the upstairs room as their headquarters.

Was reported that Mr. A.W. Thompson had injured his leg while putting wood into the city hall basement. After some discussion the following motion was presented by Councilman Dedman and seconded by Councilman Porter, That Mr. Alvin Thompson be employed by the City of Canby at an hourly rate of 75c per hour for the time he works for the City.

Also that he be sworn in as a police officer and to receive the sum of \$20.00 per month for such services which shall include supervision of city traffic and general conduct in the business section of Canby on Saturday afternoon and evenings between the hours of 4 PM-6 PM and 7 PM and 9 PM.

Mr. Thompson's duties are to be designated by Mr. Louis Lent, Supt. of Light & water depts. and also by Councilman George Koehler as supervisor of Streets and Roads, as they shall see fit. Upon vote on this motion by the Council, motion carried.

Mr. Lent gave a report on the cost of replacing the electric power line to the Union and Standard Oil plants.

City Treasurer Eid read his report for the third quarter. Treasurers report was accepted subject to audit of the finance committee.

Mayor Vinyard announced that a special meeting would be held Thursday evening at 7:30 for the purpose of canvassing the vote of Tuesdays election.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
