

Special Meeting
November 9, 1944

A special meeting of the Council was held Thursday November 9th 7:30 P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Everhart, Dedman, Krueger, Porter and Reynolds. Absent Atty. Zimmerman and Councilmen Cutsforth, Koehler and Stefani.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting was called to canvass the vote of the regular City Election held November 6th, 1944.
