City Treasurer John Eid read his report for the fourth quarter, also annual report for 1943. On motion, made and seconded, Treasurers report was accepted, subject to audit of the Finance Committee.

On motion, seconded and carried the Mayor and Recorder was instructed to purchase \$10,000.00 worth of Government Bonds during the Fourth War Loan Drive. \$5,000.00 to be taken from the Sinking Fund and \$5,000.00 from the Light Fund.

Motion was made, seconded and on vote of the Council carried that the Cemetery Fund repay \$1,500.00 to the Sinking Fund.


Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Council approve the election of Fred Stefani as Fire Chief.
