April 3, 1944

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday April 3, 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Everhart, Koehler, Pfister, Porter and Reynolds. Councilmen Cutsforth and Gesik reported later. Councilman Stefani absent.

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On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were ordered paid. Yeas 7, nays 0.

Mr. Lent reported that work had been started on the new well. Motion was made, seconded and carried authorizing Mr. Lent to purchase the necessary 6" iron pipe to connect the two wells. He also recommended that the water tank be cleaned out. After discussion was decided to clean the tank on the night of the 20th. water to be turned off at 9 P.M.

Mr. Koehler gave an outline of the streets about town that needed repair. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the streets as outlined by Mr. Koehler be resurfaced.

Motion was made, seconded and carried authorizing the Mayor and Recorder to sign a Resolution to the Highway Commission covering the work to be done on the streets with funds received from the Highway Commission.

City Treasurer Eid read his report for the first quarter of 1944. Treasurers report was accepted subject to audit of the Finance Committee.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
