On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were ordered paid. Yeas 5, nays 0.

Mr. Lent reported that the first fifteen feet of the tank at the new well had been poured. After discussion was decided that Engineer Milln should determine the proper time for removing the forms from the concrete. Mr. Lent stated that two new 15 A. transformers would be needed.

With approval of the Council Mayor Vinyard announced that the week of May 15th, would be clean-up week, pickups to be made on the South side on the 18th, and on the North side the 19th.

On motion, made seconded and carried a beer license application by Rose E. Rice was approved.

On motion, seconded and carried the Mayor and Recorder was authorized to make application to the Bonneville Power Administration for service on their new E-2 rate schedule.
