

Special Meeting  
June 2, 1944

A meeting of the City Council and the Budget Committee was held at the City Hall June 2, 1944. On roll call the following members of the Council were present, Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Everhart, Koehler, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Budget Committee members present were George Cattley, Peter Kylo, Ed. Krueger, Carl Lucke, George Berg, Wilmer Sandness, Carl Elligsen and E.O. Mueller.

Minutes of the Budget Committee meeting held May 12th. was read.

A petition signed by the Library Board, requesting that the appropriation for the library be increased was read by the Recorder. After considerable discussion the following <sup>amended</sup> budget was adopted by unanimous vote of those present.
