

Regular Meeting  
July 3, 1944

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday July 3, 1944, 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, City Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Koehler, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Absent Councilmen Everhart, Gesik and Pfister.

Minutes of the June meeting were read and approved. A letter from the Sheriff's Office regarding delinquent taxes of the Southern Pacific Co. was read.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were ordered paid. Yeas 5, Nays 0.

Chief of Police Hansen requested time off for a vacation. Motion was made, seconded and carried that Hansen, Lent and Kendall be granted vacations, time for taking same to be arranged at a later date.

Councilman Koehler reported that some of the streets had been graveled.

Ordinance #339, levying a tax on all the taxable property, both real and personal, within the city limits of Canby, came up for final action. On vote of the Council motion carried. Yeas 5, Nays 0.

Motion was made, seconded and carried authorizing the purchase of War Bonds to the amount of \$10,000.00. The amount to be purchased and the fund from which the money would be taken was left to the City Treasurer to determine. Vote on motion was Yeas 5, Nays 0.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
