

Special Meeting,
October 20, 1943

A special meeting of the Council was held Wednesday October 20th, 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting was called to consider the improvement and enlargement of the Water system. After discussion Ordinance #338, for the improvement and enlargement of the water system for the City of Canby was read. On vote of the Council Ordinance #338 was passed on first reading and ordered posted.

The matter of deputizing the Grade School Janitor as Special Police was referred to the Chief of Police.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
