

Regular Meeting
February 1, 1943

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday Feb. 1st., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Koehler, Porter and Stefani. Absent Councilmen Gesik, Pfister and Reynolds.

Councilman Porter repeated the oath of office for the current term. Minutes of the January meeting was read and approved.

On vote of the Council application for retail beer license by Ray E. Cross and J.D. Culley was approved.

The election of Fred Stefani as Fire Chief by the Volunteer Fire Dept. was approved by vote of the Council.

On motion the above claims were allowed. Yeas 5, nays 0.

Mr. Sorenson addressed the Council regarding taking over the duties as caretaker at the Cemetery. After discussion motion was made seconded and carried that the Cemetery Committee be authorized to hire Mr. Sorenson as Cemetery Caretaker at the rate of \$50.00 per month and the City furnish him the house on the Cemetery property to live in.

By motion, seconded and carried the Recorder was instructed to notify Lester Hess by registered mail to vacate the Cemetery premises, as is, by not later than March 8th. 1943.

Fire Chief Stefani reported the Department answered three calls during the month. Also read a report of the rural Fire Dist. since it was formed.

Ordinance #336, providing for the removal of dangerous buildings came up for final action by the Council. On vote of the Council Ordinance #336 was passed. Yeas 5, nays 0.

On motion, seconded and carried Councilman Cutsforth was authorized to purchase a suitable flag for the Memorial Board.

There being no further business, on motion the Council adjourned.
