After some discussion motion was made, seconded and carried that new rates of pay for City Employees be established as follows: Common labor .65 per hour—Chief of Police \$125.00 per month—Night Watchman \$135.00 per month—Light & Water Supt. \$175.00 per month plus 5% on collections.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the purchase and installation of a hot water tank and other necessary plumbing work be authorized to be done on the house at the Cemetery.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
