On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were ordered paid. Yeas 6, nays 0.

Mr. Lent reported that no work had been done on the well.

Fire Chief Stefani reported the dept. answered two calls during the month. One call outside of town, no damage. One call within town, loss about \$1,000.00.

After discussion the following motion was introduced and passed by the Council. Whereas the old building on the back of the Dedman property is a hazard to the adjacent property, the Council demands that this hazard be removed within 10 days after receipt of notice to remove same by the owner.

Fire Chief Stefani requested the purchase of new fire hose for the Dept.


Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Fire Chief be authorized to purchase the necessary fire hose.
