August 2, 1943

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday August 2, 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Fire Chief Stefani reported the department answered three calls during the month. No loss within the city limits. Also stated that he attended a meeting of the Oregon Fire Chiefs held at Salem July 19th.

After discussion motion was made, seconded and carried authorizing the City Attorney to proceed to collect delinquent taxes owed by the Southern Pacific Co. and the Pacific Fruit Express Co.
