October 13, 1942

A special meeting of the Council was held Tuesday October 13th. 7:30 P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Absent Atty. Zimmerman and Councilmen Everhart and Gesik.

After the meeting was called to order by Mayor Vinyard, Mr. Mueller stated that he would <sup>354</sup> ~~79~~ the City of Canby a strip of land thru his property, starting at the City's present property and extending west thru his property to the western boundary, the width to be the same as the City's present property, Price to be \$1,000.00.
