

Regular Meeting
November 2, 1942

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday November 2, 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, City Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Absent Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart and Gesik.

Minutes of the regular October meeting and special meetings of October 12th and 13th were read and approved.

Communications from Mrs. Helen I Brown, Post Master, Mr. Edward Koen and Rex Albright were read.

Regarding the request of Mrs. Brown for a "No Parking Zone" in front of the Post Office, Motion was made, seconded and carried that a six foot No parking space be designated in front of the Post Office, providing the Post Office Dept. furnishes a suitable sign and takes care of same.

The letter from Mr. Koen requesting a contribution for the the Red Cross Emergency Car, was left on the table for future consideration.
