

Special Meeting
November 5, 1942.

A special meeting of the Council was held Thursday November 5th. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Recorder Mangus, Councilmen Everhart, Gesik, Koehler, Pfister, Porter and Reynolds. Absent Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen Councilmen Cutsforth and Stefani.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting was called to canvas the vote of the regular City Election held November 3rd. 1942.

Whereupon the Recorder read the canvas of the vote as follows:

At the direction of the Council, President of the Council Koehler Proclaimed J.R. Vinyard duly elected Mayor for the ensuing term of two years.

Mayor Vinyard proclaimed the election of the other officers as follows:

R.H. Reynolds reelected Councilman for four year term.

John Eid reelected City Treasurer for two year term.

After discussion motion was made, seconded and carried that Ralph Zimmerman be appointed City Recorder subject to his acceptance.
