On motion the above claims were allowed ^{yeas 5, nays 0} excepting bill of Francis Skinner for wiring the Firemen's room at the City Hall, this bill for \$32.46 was ordered held up until the work was approved by Mr. Lent.

Mr. Lent reported that the flow of the springs was holding up. Also stated that Mr. Hornig wanted to get a 30' length of water pipe. After discussion was instructed by the Council not to dispose of any pipe as it cannot be replaced at this time.

Ordinance #334, Relating to National Defense and providing for the observance of Black-outs and other restrictions came up for final action. On vote of the Council ordinance #334 was passed. Yeas 5, nays 0.

On motion made, seconded and carried the proposal of Donald C. Bauer to audit the City's books for the year 1941 for the sum of \$75.00 was accepted.


The election of Fred Stefani as Fire Chief by the Volunteer Fire Dept. was approved by the Council.
