March 2, 1942.

On motion the above claims were ordered paid. Yeas 6, nays 0.

Mr. Lent reported that he had ordered electric wire and purchased poles, that due to high water the test well had been delayed.

Councilman Stefani reported on the Fire Dept. activities for the year, also stated that an auxiliary organization was being formed. Requested that a short wave radio be installed in the Firemen's quarters. The committee was instructed to consider the needs of a short wave radio. Mr. Lent was also instructed to consider the matter of emergency pumping equipment.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Committee purchase and have planted globe locust trees in the parking strip around the park lots.

Mayor Vinyard stated the the Red Cross had requested that the City contribute \$50.00 toward the purchase of first aid materials for the Canby First-aid station. Motion was made, seconded and carried the City contribute \$50.00 toward the purchase of first-aid materials.

After consideration motion was made, seconded and carried that a street light be installed on Second Ave. S. between Elm and Grant Sts., as soon as possible.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
