

Special Meeting.
October 10, 1941.

A meeting of the City Council and the Budget committee was held at the City Hall Friday evening October 10th. 1941. The meeting was called to order by Mayor Vinyard. After discussion, motion by Geo. Bates, seconded by Geo. Cattley that the Budget be adopted as published. When put to a vote Budget was adopted by unanimous vote of the meeting.

There being no further business the joint meeting of the Budget Committee and the City Council adjourned.

The City Council was then called to order by Mayor Vinyard, on roll call the following were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Absent Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart and Gesik.

Ordinance #332, levying a tax on all the taxable property within the City Limits of Canby was read. On vote of the Council Ordinance # 332 was passed on first reading and ordered published.

Mayor Vinyard ask the opinion of the Council about a black-out on the night of October 31st. On motion, seconded and carried the Council agreed to co-operate with the officials in charge of the black-out program.

There being no further business the Council adjourned.
