

Special Meeting.  
December 15, 1941.

A special meeting of the Council was held Monday December 15, 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, Reynolds and Stefani. Atty Zimmerman and Councilman Gesik Absent. Councilman Everhart reported later.

Mayor Vinyard announced that the meeting was called to consider water matters and defense measures.

Various means of obtaining more water was discussed. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Water Supt. proceed on the two locations as discussed.

Mayor Vinyard stated that the Defense Council had requested that six Special Police be authorized for Canby. After discussion, motion was made, seconded and carried that the Mayor be authorized to appoint deputy Police as he sees fit to handle defense work.

Fire Chief Kraft requested the Council to fit up sleeping quarters in the attic of the City Hall. Stated the cost of sealing a 16'x 26' room would be about \$195.00. Motion was made, seconded and carried that the Fire Chief be authorized to have quarters fixed up.

There being no further business on motion the meeting adjourned.
