

Regular Meeting.  
May 5, 1941.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday May 5th. 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen, Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Everhart, Koehler, Porter and Stefani. Absent Councilmen Gesik, Pfister and Reynolds.

Minutes of the April meeting were read and approved.

Communications from the Canby Parent-Teachers Association and from the Canby Flying Service were read by the Recorder.

Mr. Berney, spokesman for a delegation representing the Band Boosters Club of Canby, addressed the Council requesting financial support for their summer program. After consideration ordinance #329, contributing \$100.00 to the Band Boosters Club of Canby was passed on first reading and ordered published.

Mr. Lent discussed with the Council the performance of the new well. After discussion was referred to the water committee for action.

Ben Hansen stated the utility truck needed a motor overhaul and new tires. Motion was made, seconded and carried that Mr. Porter be authorized to make the needed repairs on the truck.

City Treasurer John Eid read his reports for the fourth quarter of 1940 and the first quarter of 1941, also annual report for 1940. Motion was made, seconded and carried that Treasurer's report be accepted subject to audit of the Finance Committee.
