

Regular Meeting.
June 2, 1941.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held Monday June 2nd., 8 o'clock P.M. On roll call there were present Mayor Vinyard, Atty. Zimmerman, Chief of Police Hansen Recorder Mangus and Councilmen Cutsforth, Koehler, Pfister, Porter, and Stefani. Councilman Everhart reported later, Councilmen Gesik and Reynolds absent.

Minutes of the May meeting were read and approved.

A communication from Lester Hess, requesting an increase in pay for work at the Cemetery was read by the Recorder.

On motion, seconded and carried the above claims were allowed. Yeas 6, nays 0.

Mr. Lent gave a report on the testing of the well, also stated that the pump would be repaired shortly.

Mr. Koehler reported that all street signs had not yet been completed or erected. The matter of selecting locations for street signs was left with the Committee.

After discussion motion was made, seconded and carried that the City would furnish right of way to the County for the bridge over the Molalla River.

The matter of an increase in pay to Lester Hess was referred to the Cemetery Committee.

Ordinance # 329, contributing \$100.00 to the Band Boosters Club of Canby came up for final action. On vote of the Council was passed. Yeas 6, nays 0.

Ordinance # 330 to amend the rules and regulations of the Zion Cemetery, relating to permanent maintenance was passed on first reading.

Motion was made, seconded and carried that lots sold under the permanent maintenance provision, \$110.00 per lot or \$55.00 per half lot be placed in an irreducible fund to provide for cost of upkeep.

The Recorder was instructed to send a letter of thanks to all of those participating in the Memorial Day services held at the Cemetery.

There being no further business on motion the Council adjourned.
